COMMUNITY MEDICINE / DISEASE PREVENTION

Provides immunizations, TB, STD and HIV screenings and case management, family planning services, Nurse of the Day services, children's medical services and insurance (MA/MCHP), and lead poisoning prevention. **410-479-8000**

WELLNESS PROGRAMS - Provides no-cost breast, cervical, and colorectal cancer screenings (if eligible), tobacco/smoking prevention and cessation, electronic cigarette education, enforcement of tobacco sales laws, prevention of chronic diseases and more. **410-479-8080**
